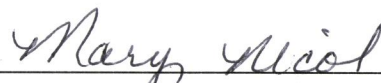
A Work Session of the Douglas City Council was held on September 9, 2021, at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 101 N. 4th Street, Douglas, Wyoming.

Councilmembers Present: Mayor René Kemper, Councilperson John Bartling, Councilperson Kim Pexton, Councilperson Ron McNare, and Councilperson Monty Gilbreath @5:30 p.m.

Also Present: Jonathan Teichert, City Administrator; Mary Nicol, Administrative Services Director/Treasurer; Todd Byerly, PD Chief; Cindy Porter, The Enterprise; Paige Fenton Hughes, Converse County School District; Mark Horr, Converse County School District; Mark Nelson, Wyoming Department of Transportation.

Discussion Regarding Recreation Master Plan: Administrator Teichert and Superintendent Fenton Hughes provided an overview of a Joint Recreation Master Plan to include the School District, Converse County and City of Douglas including possible options; plans for operation and hours and potential contribution of \$10,000 for payment of the Master Plan. Discussion regarding other options and concerns with a concurrence to support the \$10,000 for the plan to review options. **Discussion Regarding Douglas Middle School Intersection:** Administrator Teichert reviewed the cost to place a flashing overhead light at the intersection and questions if this would affect the recent change of this route to our truck route. Mark Nelson, Wyoming Department of Transportation representative advised this was acceptable, however, we may see more road damage at the intersection. Discussion occurred regarding additional needs with concurrence no additional changes needed.

Discussion Regarding Taser Contract: Chief of Police Byerly reviewed options of a taser contract rather than outright purchase of a few tasers as budgeted. Discussion occurred regarding contract with concurrence to move forward with a contract. **Review of Regular City Council Agenda for September 13, 2021:** Administrator Teichert provided an overview of the upcoming agenda advising that we would be adding the Engineering contract with CEPI to extend for this fiscal year. **Council Reports:** Councilperson McNare advised he was contacted by Lone Tree and they are considering removing trash services and taking care of on their own. Discussion occurred regarding this matter. **Administrator's Report:** Administrator Teichert provided an overview of upcoming meetings and events. **Adjourn – No further discussion and the Work Session was adjourned at approximately 5:38 p.m.**
